

What is Hospice Palliative Care?

The Canadian Hospice Palliative Care Association states that Hospice Palliative Care (HPC):

- aims to relieve suffering and improve the quality of living and dying.
- is appropriate for any person and/or family living with a life-threatening illness due to any diagnosis.
- may complement or enhance disease-modifying therapy or it may become the total focus of care.
- is most effectively delivered by an interdisciplinary team of healthcare providers.

HPC Services

HPC consultants:

- assist service providers in the application of the Model to Guide Hospice Palliative Care, assessment tools and best practice guidelines.
- offer consultation to service providers in person, by telephone, or through e-mail regarding care, e.g., assessment and management of pain and other symptoms; they do not provide direct care.
- provide case-based education and mentoring for service providers.
- link providers with specialized hospice palliative care resources.
